# Congratulations to our successful Year 12 Class on achieving outstanding SACE results.

## Saints' Girls Reach Their Full Potential.

St Peter's Girls' School is delighted to announce the outstanding South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) results.

The 2012 Year 12 students have worked diligently throughout the year and the School is very proud of their overall performance.

- 100% of Year 12s attained their SACE
- 68% received an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) of more than 90 which places them in the top 10%
- More than 44% received an ATAR of over 95 which places them in the top 5%
- 32% were placed in the top 2% of the state (the highest number of students that St Peter's Girls has ever had in the top 2%)

Collectively, the 2012 SACE Stage 2 (Year 12) students received 40 Merit Awards, particularly in Biology, Chemistry, English Studies, English Communications and the Research Project. Of particular note, of all the A+ scores awarded in the State for English Studies, 15% were awarded to our students along with 10% awarded to our Biology students.

Our academic results are consistently well above the State average. Since the introduction of the Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER) in 1997 more than 50% of our Year 12 students have recorded a TER in the top 10% of the State.
