Median ATAR of 95.75

We are very proud of the 59 students in the Year 12 Class of 2013. Their exceptional results are a testament to their hard work, diligence and sacrifice. It is no surprise that every girl attained her SACE. We congratulate the Year 12s on achieving outstanding SACE results with a median Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) of 95.75.



Class of 2013 tops the State

Seventeen per cent of our students received an ATAR of more than 99 and more than 28 per cent ranked above 98. Fifty-five per cent of our girls were placed in South Australia's top 5 per cent of high-performing students. This is the highest number of students that St Peter's Girls has ever had in the 'Top 5 per cent'. This remarkable result tops last year's then record of 44 per cent.

Merit Awards

Collectively, the class received 35 Merit Awards in Biology, Chemistry, Drama, English Communications,

English Studies, Information Technology, Maths Applications, Maths Methods, Maths Studies, Modern History, Music Solo Performance, Music Ensemble, Research Project and Specialist Maths.

The class received 15 per cent of the State's 'A+' results for English Students, 33 per cent for Information Technology and 10 per cent for History. Merits were also achieved in each mathematics subject, with one-third of the Specialist Maths class receiving merits.

Perfect scores

We congratulate Year 12 graduates Dione Jones and Dux of the School,

Erica Ang, both of whom studied six Stage 2 subjects over two years and achieved perfect scores of 99.95.

Erica received six merits in Chemistry, English Communications, Modern History, Nutrition, Biology and Research Project. Dione received six merits in Biology, Chemistry, English Studies, Modern History, Research Project and Solo Performance (Music).

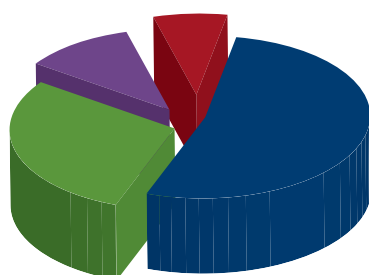
Dione and Erica received a Governor of South Australia Commendation, which recognises their outstanding academic excellence.
