Reach great heights at St Peter's Girls

We are delighted to present the achievements of our Year 12 Class of 2014.

This year, we welcome our inaugural graduates of the IB Diploma Programme alongside our SACE cohort. To offer dual learning pathways, and yet maintain such outstanding results, is worthy of celebration.

Merit Awards

Collectively, our students received 41 Merit Awards across SACE and IB subjects, in areas as diverse as Biology, Chemistry, Drama, English, Information Technology, Mathematics, History and Research Project.

Tess Murray was awarded the highest accolade possible in English Studies, the Tennyson Medal. For the third year in a row, a St Peter's Girls' student has received this prestigious honour. In the IB, Ashleigh Killen was one of only three South Australian students who were awarded the CAS

Results at a glance – SACE and IB

Dux of the School

A special mention must go to Lauren Simpson, who achieved the top ATAR result of our SACE cohort of 99.9, including Merit Awards in Chemistry, Biology, English Studies and Mathematical Studies.

Our IB Dux was Vienna Tran, who achieved an ATAR equivalent of 99.10. Two of our IB students achieved bilingual Diplomas in both Chinese and English.

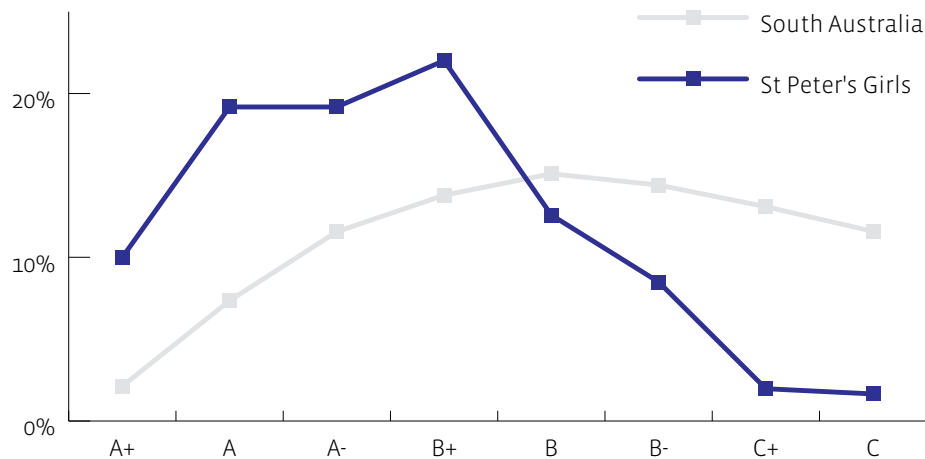
SACE Results

Median ATAR 95.15

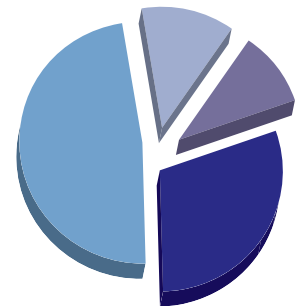
