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## Tasting Notes:

### Sparkling

#### *Nv The Lane Lois Blanc de Blanc*

Crunchy green apple, lemon and lime flavours with a fine bead and taut acid length.

#### *Nv Bird in Hand Sparkling Pinot Noir*

The benchmark pink bubbly in the Australian market, with a fabulous salmon pink colour, lifted strawberry aromas and a creamy palate full of soft strawberry and cherry fruits.

### Whites & Rosé

#### *Golding The Local Adelaide Hills Sauv Blanc*

This wine has a delicate perfume of green apple, lime and passionfruit while on the palate you will find generous notes of crunchy snow pea shoots and lifted tropical fruit flavours. It lingers on the palate and ends with a refreshing dry and chalky finish.

#### *Richard Hamilton Adelaide Hills Pinot Gris*

With a bouquet of delicate nectarine and peach aroma with a hint of ginger. An elegant, silky textured palate with soft acidity and persistent flavour.

#### *Pauletts Clare Valley Riesling*

Dry-grown riesling from a famed sub-region of the Clare Valley. Intensity is up this year. The flavour strikes from the first sip. Intense lime and mineral, perhaps some gunmetal, perhaps some lime leaf. There's a vague kind of chalky spritz character too, and it's a positive. A lovely young riesling.

#### *d'Arenberg Olive Grove Chardonnay*

Considerable weight with a lovely mid palate of white peach, lime and a touch of brioche. There is zesty acidity that builds on the palate to a long savoury finish with a hint of cashew nut and faint, fine, textural tannins.

#### *Bird in Hand Adelaide Hills Rosé*

A smash hit at Wimbledon year after year, with plenty of flavour but light on its feet and a dusky pink colour, this wine is fresh and lively with delicate strawberry and cherry fruit flavours.

### Reds

#### *d'Arenberg The High Trellis Cab Sauv*

A little less rustic and tannic than many d'Arenberg wines this is nonetheless packed with an intensity of fruit and tannin you don't normally see in wines at this price-point. This wine has a very pretty nose, with blueberries and perfume giving way to some serious and savoury greenery. The palate is full bodied and fresh, showing blue fruits, cherries and sage. There's great fruit intensity and length.

#### *d'Arenberg Stump Jump McLaren Vale GSM*

A riotous blend of juicy raspberry Grenache, plummy Shiraz and savoury Mourvedre – classic easy drinking McLaren Vale red at a great price.

#### *Torbreck Woodcutters Barossa Valley Shiraz*

Full of freshness and bright youthful fruits, the 2018 vintage brings an opulence and class to the wines. Aromatic plum and raspberries with freshness and balance, the wine has a round central core of red fruit that gives way to a complex mid-palate full of cassis, dark cherry, spice and vanilla. While offering immense pleasure in its youth, the 2018 Woodcutters Shiraz will certainly develop into an impressive wine with a few more years in the cellar.

### Cleanskins

#### *Cleanskin Adelaide Hills Sauv Blanc*

Zesty tropical citrus fruit from the cool Adelaide Hills with hints of sweet passionfruit, cut grass and nettles land a crisp and lively finish.

#### *Cleanskin Barossa Valley Shiraz*

Lovely dark colour, full of ripe raspberry fruit and spice – fabulously easy drinking red wine from the heart of the Barossa.
