



School Bus Service

Our School provides a personalised bus service to pick up and drop off your daughter at your door (when and where possible as determined by the Bus Manager) in the areas indicated on the map on the following page.

To use the School bus service, students are required to register as a bus passenger, indicating the route to be used and if a Term Pass is required.

The Bus Manager will then contact the family to discuss the bus route and confirm location and time of pick up/drop off.

After registering, parents of bus passengers will be sent the following information:

Costs and Charging

Term Pass \$290.00 per term

A Term Pass covers all trips to and from School for the relevant term.

Casual use: \$6.50 per trip

Bus drivers maintain a roll of students travelling on the bus and where a student does not have a Term Pass the number of trips (one-way to or from School) that she travels in a term will be invoiced at the end of the term.

Bus Runs

Morning Runs

In the mornings, students need to arrive at School by 8.20am and it is important that all students using the bus service are at the appropriate location for pick up at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time. Bus drivers are not able to wait for students who are late as this causes all girls on the bus to be late to School. Younger students (Year 4 or below) should not be left to wait for the bus on their own.

Afternoon Runs

In the afternoons the buses leave the School at 3.45pm.

Delays

When the bus is late arriving at the pick-up/drop off point parents are asked to wait 15 minutes after the due time before contacting the bus driver.

If the bus breaks down alternative arrangements will be made by the bus driver with regard to picking up/dropping off students.

In most cases this will result in another School bus being sent for the students but may require parent help at times.

Student Safety

Parents are expected to stay with their daughters until they are picked up and to be waiting to meet them when they are dropped off.

Parents are advised to have a back-up plan in the situation that they will be late to meet their daughter at the drop off location. If there is no-one to meet the student, parents must ring the driver on the bus's mobile telephone to make suitable arrangements. Students will not be left at drop off locations on their own without the prior approval of parents and no younger students (Year 4 or below) will be left on their own.

A younger student (Year 4 or below) will not be dropped off unless a parent is waiting for her (or alternative arrangements have been

made with the bus driver). The bus driver will contact the parents to make alternative arrangements.

Uniform and Behaviour

While waiting for the bus and after alighting from it outside the School grounds, students must comply with the School rules (as set down in the Diary) regarding uniform.

Hats must be worn with the summer uniform, and if the jumper is worn with the summer uniform, the blazer must also be worn. The blazer must be worn with the winter uniform.

The School rules regarding behaviour apply to all students catching the School buses. Each bus has an appointed Bus Monitor who is responsible for enforcing the rules regarding uniform and behaviour.

In addition, the bus specific rules apply to ensure safety of all passengers and the driver.

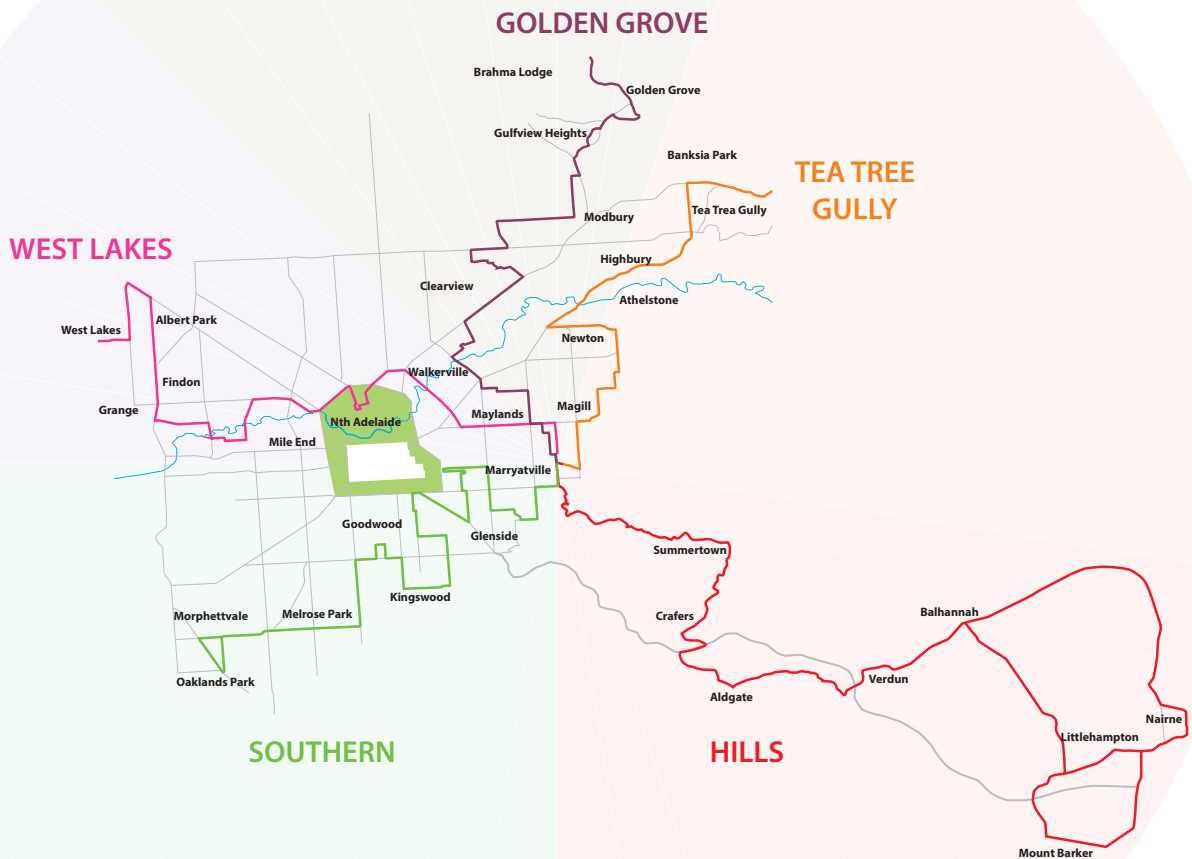
