



Academic Scholarship

A range of academic scholarships are open to high-achieving students each year. Each scholarship provides part remission of tuition fees, as determined by the Principal. Please note that other charges, such as the Fixed Charge and ICT Levy, are to be met by the candidates' parents/guardians.

Examination and supporting documents

Applicants wishing to be considered for an academic scholarship must register with the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) testing program. An application fee of \$110 will be required to enrol in the testing program.

The testing will take place at St Peter's Girls. Please check the St Peter's Girls' School website for information on application deadlines and testing dates.

Registrations can only be made online via our website.

Additionally, we require formal submissions from applicants, containing:

- > a copy of your daughter's two most recent school reports
- > most recent NAPLAN test results
- > a sample of her written work (for example, an essay or short story)
- > a cover letter written by your daughter outlining her interests, achievements and reasons why she would like to attend St Peter's Girls' School.

All documentation must be received by the School prior to the ACER test date. No original copies should be included in your application as documents cannot be returned.

Application process

Girls will be short-listed based on their academic performance in the examination and the strength of their supporting documentation. Short-listed candidates may then attend an interview with the Principal and Head of Sub-School.

Successful applicants will be contacted by telephone and unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing. In the event that candidates successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.

There will be an annual review process of all scholarship recipients involving the Principal, Head of Sub-School and other appropriate staff. It is a requirement of these scholarships that successful applicants maintain academic performance, contribute fully to the life of the School and adhere to all School rules and expectations, whilst displaying conduct of a high standard.
