



The Principal's All-Rounder Scholarship

Each year a select number of Principal's All-Rounder Scholarships may be awarded to external students only entering Years 7 – 11. These scholarships are awarded to prospective students who have proven all-round ability (through to Year 12) on the basis of school reports, references, evidence of high level participation in extra-curricular activities and leadership potential.

Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form, as well as a supporting portfolio. The portfolio must contain an index page, as well as copies (not originals) of the following documents in the order listed:

- > Copy of latest two School reports
- > Copy of the most recent National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy Test (NAPLAN) results
- > Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example national testing, debating and public speaking)
- > References from teachers, performing arts teachers, coaches or mentors
- > Evidence of selection in sports at State or higher level
- > Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- > Evidence of participation in the Performing Arts, such as dance, drama or music at a high level
- > Involvement in community groups or clubs
- > Any other relevant documents that will support the application

A short-list of candidates will be selected for interviews with the Principal and Head of Middle School or Head of Senior School. The scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process including the Principal and the Head of Sub School.

The scholarship remission will be at the discretion of the Principal. Please note that other charges, such as the Fixed Charge and ICT Levy, are to be met by the candidates' parents/guardians.
