Old Scholars' Association Scholarship

Each year an Old Scholars' Association Scholarship may be awarded to an **external student** entering Years 5 to 8. This scholarship is awarded through to Year 12 to a prospective student who has proven all-round ability on the basis of school reports, references, evidence of high level participation in extra-curricular activities and leadership potential. Additionally, the applicant must have a connection to the School through a family member having attended St Peter's Girls in the past.

The Old Scholars' Association Scholarship will provide for a 30% reduction on tuition fees for the life of the scholarship and it is expected that recipients of this scholarship will contribute to the Old Scholars Council during their time at school. Other charges, such as the Fixed Charge and the ICT Levy, are to be met by the recipient's parents or guardians.

Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form, as well as a supporting portfolio. The portfolio must contain copies (not originals) of the following documents in the order listed:

- > Copy of latest two School reports
- > Copy of the most recent National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy Test (NAPLAN) results
- > Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example national testing, debating and public speaking)
- > References from teachers, performing arts teachers, coaches or mentors
- > Evidence of participation in competitive sport/s at a high level
- > Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- > Involvement in community groups or clubs
- > Any other relevant documents that will support the application

A short-list of candidates will be selected for interviews with the Principal, Head of Middle School and President of the Old Scholars' Association. The scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard. In the event that candidates successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.

Scholarship applications for commencement in 2021 should include a completed Application Form together with the requested documentation outlined in a presentation portfolio.
