St Peter's Girls' School offers a range of Scholarships to encourage excellence across teaching and learning programs available at the School.

Academic Scholarships

For entry to Years 5 – 11

A number of Academic Scholarships are awarded annually to current and external students entering Years 5 – 11. Applicants are required to sit the Australian Council for Education Research (ACER) testing to be eligible. These tests are held at the School in early February each year and successful recipients will receive a reduction on tuition fees.

Applications open in September each year and close in January.

Music Scholarships

For entry to Years 7 – 11

Each year, a limited number of Music Scholarships may be awarded to both external and current students entering Years 7 – 11. The purpose of this scholarship is to recognise outstanding talent within the School, encourage students outside the School to join on the basis of extraordinary talent and to complement the needs of our Music programs.

The scholarship entitles students to a fee remission at the Principal's discretion. The recipient is expected to contribute to the Music program at the School, make solid academic progress and display conduct of a high standard.

Applications are considered twice a year. First round applications close in January and second round in April for external students only.

Principal's Scholarships

For entry to Years 7 – 11

A select number of Principal's Scholarships are awarded annually to external students entering Years 7 – 11. These Scholarships are awarded through to Year 12 to prospective students who have a strong academic record and a proven ability to perform at an elite level in an extra-curricular pursuit (for example, State level sport or outstanding achievement and leadership in the Performing Arts).

From the scholarship applications received, a shortlist of candidates will be selected for interviews with the Principal. The scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls' School; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making solid academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard.

Applications are considered twice a year. First round applications close in February and second round in May.

Old Scholars' Association Scholarship

For entry to Years 5 – 8

Each year, an Old Scholars' Association Scholarship may be awarded to an external student entering Year 5 – 8. This scholarship is awarded through to Year 12 to a prospective student who has proven all-round ability on the basis of school reports, references, evidence of high-level participation in extra-curricular activities and leadership potential. Additionally, the applicant must have a connection to the School through a family member having attended St Peter's Girls in the past.

From the scholarship applications received, a shortlist of candidates will be selected for interviews. The scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the recipient will make solid academic progress, contribute to the life of the School and display conduct of a high standard.

Applications open in November each year and close in May.

International Baccalaureate Scholarship

For entry to Years 10 – 11

To support the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme provided at St Peter's Girls' School, we offer two entrance scholarships for external students who wish to undertake the IB Diploma. This scholarship will provide part remission of tuition fees as determined by the Principal and will be offered for Years 11 and 12. This scholarship is only applicable to students studying the IB Diploma.

The International Baccalaureate Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the application submitted as outlined on our School website, an interview with the Principal and IB Coordinator and, in addition, applicants may also be required to write an essay.

The scholarship will be awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls' School. The continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making solid academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard.

Applications are considered twice a year. First round applications close in February and second round in May.
