## The Principal's Scholarship

Each year a select number of Principal's Scholarships may be awarded to external students entering Years 7 – 11. To be eligible, students must have a strong academic record and a proven ability to perform at an elite level in an extra curricular pursuit (for example, State level sport or outstanding achievement and leadership in Performing Arts).

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form, as well as a supporting portfolio. The portfolio must contain copies (not originals) of the following documents:

- Copy of latest two School reports
- Copy of the most recent National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy Test (NAPLAN) results
- Copy of current scholarship offer/conditions (if your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school)

In addition, please provide copies of the following applicable documents:

- Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example, national testing, debating and public speaking)
- References from teachers, Performing Arts teachers, coaches or mentors
- Evidence of selection in sports at State or higher level
- Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- Evidence of accreditation in the Performing Arts, such as dance or drama at a high level
- Any other relevant documents that will support the application

A short-list of candidates will be selected for interviews with the Principal and Deputy Principals. The scholarships are awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process including the Principal and the Head of Sub School.

The scholarship remission amount will apply to tuition fees and will be at the discretion of the Principal. Please note that other charges, such as the Fixed Charge and ICT Levy, are to be met by the candidates' parents/guardians.
