About the Role

Our School is seeking an English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) Teacher, for the teaching of EAL/D across ELC to Year 10. This is a part-time, one-year contract position commencing in Term 1 2024. The role will involve working side-by-side with the EAL/D Specialist and classroom teachers and teaching small EAL/D withdrawal classes in our purpose-built space. Assessing using the LEAP Levels will be a key component, as well as co-developing English learning goals and appropriate support structures and programs for individual students.

Teachers are directly responsible to the Principal through the relevant members of the Senior Leadership Team. In line with the National Standards for Teachers, a teacher should demonstrate the professional knowledge, practice and engagement of Proficient or Highly Accomplished Teachers.
