St Peter's Girl's School Music Scholarship

Talented musicians entering Years 7 - 11 in 2025 can apply for our dedicated Music Scholarship. Applicants may be current or external students.

Applicants with outstanding ability but who are entering into Years 5 and 6 may also apply in special circumstances.

Each scholarship provides part remission of tuition fees, as determined by the Principal. Please note that other charges, such as the Fixed Charge and ICT Levy, are to be met by the candidates' parents/guardians.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants must demonstrate exceptional ability in Music
- Applicants who perform outstandingly on more than one instrument or voice will have this taken into account
- Applicants applying for entry into Years 7 9 should be of a minimum Grade 4 AMEB standard or equivalent
- Applicants applying for entry into Years 10 -11 should be of a minimum Grade 6 AMEB standard or equivalent
- Piano players entering into Years 7 9 should be of a minimum Grade 6 AMEB standard. A second instrument to approximately Grade 4 standard is strongly encouraged.
- Vocalists must have at least three years of vocal tuition

APPLICATION

To apply for a Music Scholarship please submit copies of the following documents (no originals) with the completed application form:

- Copies of AMEB certificates and reports
- · Copies of past two academic reports
- The most recent National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy (NAPLAN) test results from current educational institution
- Evidence of the student's musical ability, such as exam results and references
- Copy of current scholarship offer/conditions (if your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school)

APPLICATION PROCESS

The scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School, displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process involving the Principal and the Director of Music to examine the student's performance and involvement in the Music program at St Peter's Girls.

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted to arrange an audition and interview time. The audition and interview will take approximately 30 minutes. Auditions will be assessed by the Director of Music. Each candidate is required to present two contrasting pieces of work lasting no more than 5 minutes each. It is therefore advisable that students select their audition pieces carefully and with the guidance of their teacher. Students must provide their own accompanist for the audition. Students may also be required to sight read or complete technical exercises.

Following the audition, an interview may be conducted with the Deputy Principal. The auditions will be held within 3 weeks of the close date for each application round. The outcome of the audition and interview is final.

The successful candidate must commit to:

- study classroom Music through to Year 12
- be an ambassador for Music, within and outside the School
- perform in the biennial School musical and at least once each calendar year in a School assembly or Chapel service
- participate in two co-curricular musical groups
- participate in the Music Tour and Music camp
- demonstrate outstanding commitment and application in all curriculum areas and abide by the ethos, requirements and expectations of the School

Unsuccessful candidates will be notified in writing. In the event that candidates successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.
