St Peter's Girls' School International Baccalaureate Scholarship

At St Peter's Girls' School, we offer International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) Scholarships for external students who wish to undertake the IBDP for Years 11 and 12. The scholarship remission amount will be at the discretion of the Principal and applies to tuition fees only. Other charges, such as the annual Fixed Charge and ICT Levy are to be met by the applicants' parents/guardians, with the exception of the IB levy for Year 11 and 12 which will be waived.

International Baccalaureate scholarships will be awarded on the basis of the criteria listed below and may also require the applicant to write an essay in addition to attending an interview with the Principal and the IBDP Coordinator.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications for this scholarship can be made by completing the attached application form and including copies of the following documents:

- Two most recent academic reports
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Academic certificates of achievement
- Evidence of participation, or achievement, in school, club or community programs in areas such as public speaking or debating, leadership roles, community service activities, sport, music, drama, visual art or other creative pursuits
- References from teachers, coaches or mentors
- A written statement outlining future goals
- If your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school a copy of her current scholarship offer and conditions
- Small headshot photo of applicant

A short-list of applicants will be selected for interview with the Principal and the IBDP Coordinator from the applications received. In the event that applicants successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.

The IBDP Scholarship will be awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard.

Please note that scholarship offers for 2027 will be subject to availability within the relevant year level.
