# Music Scholarship Entry into years 5 to 11 2027







## St Peter's Girls' School Music Scholarship

Talented musicians entering Years 5 to 11 in 2027 can apply for our dedicated Music Scholarship. Applicants may be current or external students.

The scholarship remission amount will be at the discretion of the Principal and applies to tuition fees only. Other charges, such as the annual Fixed Charge and ICT Levy are to be met by the applicants' parents/quardians.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Applicants must demonstrate exceptional ability in Music
- Applicants who perform outstandingly on more than one instrument or voice will be highly regarded
- Applicants applying for entry into our Junior School in Years 5 and 6 must demonstrate exceptional ability
- Applicants applying for entry into Years 7 to 9 should be of a minimum Grade 4 AMEB standard or equivalent
- Applicants applying for entry into Years 10 to 11 should be of a minimum Grade 6 AMEB standard or equivalent
- Piano players entering into Years 7 to 9 should be of a minimum Grade 6 AMEB standard. A second instrument to approximately Grade 4 standard is strongly encouraged
- Vocalists must have undertaken at least three years of vocal tuition

#### **APPLICATION**

To apply for a Music Scholarship please submit copies of the following documents with the completed application form:

- AMEB certificates and reports
- Two most recent academic reports
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Evidence of the student's musical ability, such as exam results and references
- If your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school, a copy of her current scholarship offer/conditions
- Small headshot photo of applicant

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Music scholarships are awarded on the understanding that recipients will complete their schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to recipients making good academic progress, contributing to

the life of the School, displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process involving the Principal and the Director of Music to examine the student's performance and involvement in the Music program at St Peter's Girls.

Only short-listed applicants will be contacted to arrange an audition and interview time. The audition and interview will take approximately 30 minutes. Instrumental auditions will be assessed by the Director of Music and vocal auditions will be assessed by the Director of Choirs. Each applicant is required to present two contrasting pieces of work lasting no more than 5 minutes each. It is therefore advisable that students select their audition pieces carefully and with the guidance of their teacher. Students must provide their own accompanist for the audition, including bringing their own instruments (with the exception of Piano). Students may also be required to sight read or complete technical exercises.

Following the audition, an interview may be conducted with the Principal. The auditions will be held within 3 weeks of the close date, and the outcome of the audition and interview is final.

The successful applicant must commit to:

- Study classroom Music through to Year 12
- Be an ambassador for Music within and outside the School
- Perform in the biennial School musical and at least once each calendar year in a School assembly or Chapel service
- Participate in a minimum of two co-curricular musical groups
- Participate in the School Music Tour and Music camp
- Demonstrate outstanding leadership, commitment and application in all curriculum areas
- Abide by the ethos requirements and expectations of the School

Unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing. In the event that applicants successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.
