# St Peter's Girls' School Principal's Scholarship

The Principal's Scholarship at St Peter's Girls' School is testament to our commitment to nurturing exceptional individuals who embody the core values of our School: Courage, Creativity, and Compassion. We believe that these values are not only central to experiencing a successful academic journey but are also pivotal to developing responsible and empathetic leaders of tomorrow.

External students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2027 are eligible to apply for our Principal's Scholarship. As part of the application process an introductory letter should be written, of no more than 500 words, by the applicant that addresses the criteria below:

## Courage

Describe a specific situation in your life where you have demonstrated courage.

This could be a personal challenge, a time you stood up for what you believed in, or any instance where you had to step out of your comfort zone. Explain how this experience has influenced your character and how it aligns with the spirit of courage we value at St Peter's Girls.

## Creativity

Share an example of a project, initiative, or endeavour where you showcased your creativity.

This could be an artistic creation, an innovative solution to a problem, or a unique approach to a task.

Reflect on how your creative thinking can contribute to our school community and how you intend to continue nurturing your creativity at St Peter's Girls.

## Compassion

Detail your involvement in any community service, volunteer work, or initiatives that demonstrate your compassion for others.

Discuss the impact these experiences have had on both you and the community you served. Explain how you envisage incorporating compassion into your academic pursuits and extracurricular activities at St Peter's Girls.

## Leadership and Involvement

Describe your involvement in school clubs, sports, or other extracurricular activities.

Emphasise any leadership roles you have held or teamwork experiences that have shaped your character. Explain how you plan to contribute to our school's culture of involvement and leadership.

## Goals and Aspirations

Share your short-term and long-term goals. Explain how receiving the Principal's Scholarship would help you to achieve these aspirations. Discuss why St Peter's Girls is the ideal place for you to pursue your goals and how you plan to make the most of this opportunity.

Please note that scholarship offers for 2027 will be subject to availability within the relevant year level.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

In addition to the introductory letter, applicants must submit a completed Scholarship Application Form, as well as a supporting portfolio. The portfolio must contain copies of the following documents:

- Two most recent academic reports
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- If your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school, a copy of her current scholarship offer/conditions
- Small headshot photo of applicant

In addition, please provide copies of the following applicable documents:

- Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example, national testing, debating and public speaking)
- References from teachers, coaches or mentors
- Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- Evidence of any co-curricular achievements
- Evidence of awards received
- Any other relevant documents that will support the initiatives discussed in the introductory letter

A short-list of applicants will be selected to interview with the Principal. A Principal's Scholarship will be awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard and an annual review process involving the appropriate Head of Sub School.

The scholarship remission amount will be at the discretion of the Principal and applies to tuition fees only. Other charges, such as the annual Fixed Charge and ICT Levy are to be met by the applicants' parents/guardians.
