

## St Peter's Girls' School Old Scholars' Association Scholarship

Each year an Old Scholars' Association Scholarship may be awarded to an external student entering Years 5 to 8. This scholarship is awarded through to Year 12 to a prospective student who has proven all-round ability based on school reports, references, evidence of high level participation in extra-curricular activities and leadership potential. To be eligible, the applicant must have a direct family connection to the School. This means their mother, grandmother, or direct ancestor such as a great grandmother, must have graduated from the School.

The Old Scholars' Association Scholarship will provide for a 30% reduction on tuition fees for the life of the scholarship and it is expected that recipients of this scholarship will contribute to the Old Scholars' Council during their time at school. Other charges, such as the annual Fixed Charge and the ICT Levy, are to be met by the applicants' parents or guardians.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applicants must submit a completed Scholarship Application Form, together with a covering letter and supporting portfolio of documents.

The covering letter must be addressed to our Principal, and be no longer than 250 words which:

- · Outlines your connection to our School
- · Advises how you contribute to your school or community including any leadership roles you have upheld
- · Elaborates why you would you like to attend St Peter's Girls' School and form a part of our Old Scholars' community

To support your application, the portfolio must contain copies of the following documents:

- Two most recent academic reports
- Most recent NAPLAN report
- Academic certificates of achievement and awards (for example national testing, debating and public speaking)
- References from teachers, coaches or mentors
- · Evidence of leadership roles within current school or community
- Evidence of participation in competitive sport/s at a high level
- Involvement in community groups or clubs
- Any other relevant documents that will support the application
- · If your daughter is a scholarship holder at her current school, a copy of her current scholarship offer/conditions
- · Small headshot photo of applicant

A shortlist of applicants will be selected for interview with the Principal and Head of appropriate Sub School. The scholarship is awarded on the understanding that the recipient will complete her schooling at St Peter's Girls; however, the continuation of the scholarship is subject to the recipient making good academic progress, contributing to the life of the School and displaying conduct of a high standard. In the event that applicants successfully apply for more than one scholarship at St Peter's Girls, the School will only award one scholarship per student.

Scholarship applications for commencement in 2027 should include a completed Application Form together with the requested documentation.

Please note that scholarship offers for 2027 will be subject to availability within the relevant year level.
