Where are they now?

Following school, Jenny attended the SA Art School and played golf for the next 5 years before working for various private firms as a bookkeeper.

Soon after she married, Jenny lived and worked in London while her husband attended the Central School in London to obtain a Diploma in Printmaking and Lithography and they returned to London again in 1968.

For the last 16 years of her working life, Jenny was the Bursar at Aquinas College, which she found to be one of the most rewarding times of her working life.

After retiring in 1996, Jenny began volunteering. After some time volunteering with Meals on Wheels, Jenny became the Treasurer of the Rainbows and Vics Shops at the Women's and Children's Hospital in 2000. She continued in this role for the next 20 years until they were required to close down due to the Covid pandemic.

In 2025 Mrs Jenny Brown reached 80 years of membership at the Kooyonga Golf Club, having started as a junior member in 1945. This is the first time a member has reached this incredible milestone.

Jenny was treasurer of the Old Scholars' Association from 1961 - 1973.
